**Hello from Your Lake Jennings:** Catfishing exploded this weekend with Hermit and Cloister coves producing lots of limits. No one bait produced more than any other. A few bass are coming to bank anglers. Boaters are doing a little better by dropshotting 4" worms in 15 to 25' of water. Ika's are also performing but each bass is earned.

**Best Cat Spots:** Eagle, Cloister and Hermit Coves.

**Best Cat Bait:** Chicken livers or nightcrawlers. Use scent liberally

**Best Bass Spots:** 25 ft on all the points.

**Best Bass Lures /bait:** mudsuckers and d/s 4" morning dawn worms.

**Water Temp.** 71 degrees on surface.

**Notables:** Fri., & Sat., **John Visser** and grandson **Jake Alirez**, Lemon Grove, 10 cats, Fri. 45 minutes, Sat. 25 minutes, Eagle Cove. Sat., **Pat Flynn**, El Cajon, 5-8 cat, Hermit Cove, mackerel.

**Prognosis:** The early season night fishing pattern for channel cats is always fish shallow in the brush and the backs of the coves.
